MIDDLESEX JUNIOR GIRLS' CHAMPIONSHIP 2011

1. Qualifications

The Middlesex Junior Girls' Championship shall be open to female golfers who were Under 18 years of age on the 1 January 2011, who are members of a recognised golf club; who have Amateur Status in accordance with the current Amateur Status Rules of the R&A Rules Limited; and who hold a CONGU Handicap at date of entry. Competitors must also meet one of the following qualification criteria:

- a) Birth in the county of Middlesex
- b) Residence for the previous 6 months, with the intention of permanent residence, in a county of Middlesex
- c) Membership of a Club affiliated to the Middlesex Ladies County Golf Association.

2. Regulations

- **IT IS VITAL YOU INFORM CARI GALE IF YOU REDUCE OR INCREASE YOUR HANDICAP AFTER YOU SEND IN YOUR ENTRY.**
- A current CONGU Handicap certificate/printout must be produced when signing in. Failure to produce proof of handicap by your tee off time will result in DISQUALIFICATION. A competitor so disqualified may act as a marker.
- To be eligible for the Under 15 Prize a player must be under the age of 15 on 1st January 2011.
- The Committee reserves the right to arrange and/or alter starting times.
- In all matters, the decision of the Championship Committee is final.
- In the event of adverse conditions, the Committee reserves the right to alter the format of the competition in order to achieve a result.

3 Conditions

- The Championship shall be organised by a Committee appointed by the M.L.C.G.A and shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf, as approved by R&A Rules Limited, and with Local Rules, as may be approved by the Championship Committee.
- The Championship shall be played from the LGU tees.
- The Championship shall consist of two 18-hole stroke play rounds played over one day, for which one draw will be made.
- Any ties for the Middlesex Challenge Cup will be decided by a sudden-death play-off. All other ties shall be decided on last 18,9,6,3 or 1 hole.
- The winner shall be the player that returns the lowest 36-hole gross total score. She shall hold the Middlesex Challenge Cup for one year.
- The ball the player uses must be named on the current List of Conforming Golf Balls issued by R&A Rules Limited. Penalty for a breach is DISQUALIFICATION.
- Caddies/Trolley Pullers are NOT permitted. The penalty for a breach of this rule is DISQUALIFICATION.
- Distance Measuring Devices are NOT permitted. The penalty for a breach of this rule is DISQUALIFICATION
- It is a condition of this Championship that only competitors are allowed on the fairways. Spectators and county officials must walk to the side of the fairways and are not to give advice to any of the players.
- Use of the mobile phone is strictly prohibited on the course for players, parents and spectators, except if contacting the referee or in the case of an emergency.
- Players shall walk at all times during a stipulated round unless prior permission has been sought from the Championship Committee. Penalty for breach of condition; Stroke Play– TWO STROKES FOR EACH HOLE at which any breach occurred; maximum penalty per round: FOUR STROKES.
- If the player arrives at her starting point, ready to play, within five minutes after her starting time in the absence of circumstances which warrant waiving the penalty of disqualification under Rule 33-7, the penalty for failure to start on time is TWO STROKES in stroke play. Penalty for lateness beyond five minutes is DISQUALIFICATION.
- A Competitor shall not knowingly make use of any drug to enhance her performance. Any Competitor infringing this condition or, if asked to do so refusing to take a test, may be DISQUALIFIED.
- Each player is responsible for playing without undue delay.

IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF EACH COMPETITOR TO ENSURE THAT SHE COMPLIES WITH ALL THE REGULATIONS AND CONDITIONS OF THE COMPETITION
